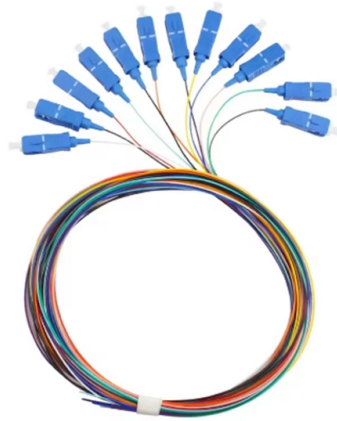

Construction and Design

24-core armored fiber optic cables typically feature single-mode or multi-mode fibers housed in gel-filled or gel-free loose tubes. The fibers are arranged around a central strength member, often a phosphatized steel wire, to provide tensile strength and prevent stretching during installation. The cable is further protected by steel tape or corrugated aluminum armoring and a polyethylene (PE) outer sheath, making it suitable for harsh environments, rodent-prone areas, and direct burial. Some designs include dry water-blocking elements to prevent moisture ingress without the need for gel, simplifying splicing and termination.
