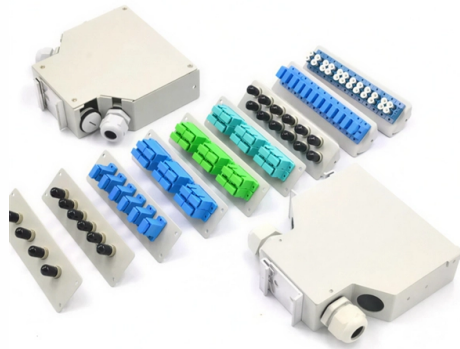


An electrical distribution box was uncovered



Overview

An “uncovered” junction box simply means it's missing its protective lid or cover. This might be a plastic box in a wall with an open front, a metal box in the attic with no lid, or even a box where the wires are just taped together with electrical tape, without any rigid enclosure. Junction boxes without covers are the most common places to find exposed and hazardous wires. A significant safety concern arises when insulation is placed directly. Uncovered junction boxes are more than just an oversight, they're a hazard that homeowners and businesses in Southlake, TX, should not ignore. These exposed electrical components can lead to a multitude of problems, from minor inconveniences to major safety risks. There are two parts: first it must be exposed, and second, it must be above a hazard threshold.
