Choosing the Right Distribution Box

Cable Routing and Bundling

- Avoid over-tightening to prevent insulation damage and overheating.
- Route cables along the sides of the box and avoid crossing over breakers unnecessarily.
- Use separate paths for high-voltage and low-voltage cables to reduce interference.
