- PPEs must be ensured (Harness, shoes, helmets). Cable tray installation may seem straightforward, but field experience reveals the same five defects appearing repeatedly across projects worldwide. From improper bonding that compromises electrical safety to missing expansion joints that lead to system damage, these common mistakes cost. The National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) also publishes three consensus standards that apply to the proper manufacture and installation of cable trays: ANSI/NEMA-VE 1-1998, Metal Cable Tray Systems; NEMA-VE 2-1996, Metal Cable Tray Installation Guidelines; and NEMA-FG-1998. Cable trays effectively lift cables off the floor, eliminating the risk of employees tripping over loose wires and causing potential injuries. Proper cable tray grounding and bonding help prevent electrical shocks and fires, safeguarding both personnel and equipment.
