Overview

Cable screens should be connected to the grounding system at both ends of the cable. Can cable trays themselves be used as grounding devices?

If cable trays are to be used as grounding points, their connection points must be grounded using flexible jumpers. Cable tray may be used as the Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC) in any installation where qualified persons will service the installed cable tray system. The metal in cable trays may be used as the EGC as per the limitations. Cable trays include cable troughs, cable trays, and cable ladders, all of which must be grounded regardless of accessibility.
