 - **Cable Management:** Use cable ties or straps to organize cables within the tray, leaving slack for expansion or future adjustments .
 - **Grounding:** For metal trays, proper electrical bonding and grounding are essential to comply with safety standards .
 - **Custom Fitting:** Flexible trays like the Wall Snake can be bent by hand to match wall contours, allowing for vertical or irregular surface installations .
