- Install a new electrical circuit: A licensed electrician can run wiring from your main electrical panel to the desired location, ensuring compliance with local electrical codes .
- Use existing power conduits: If spare conduits are available near the fiber panel, an electrician may be able to pull new electrical wiring through them safely .

- Surface-mounted or plug-in solutions: For temporary or low-power needs, consider using extension cords or power strips connected to nearby outlets, though permanent wiring is preferred for safety and code compliance .
