Most modern network switches support fiber connections through SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+ modules, which are inserted into dedicated optical ports on the switch . These modules convert electrical signals from the switch into optical signals for transmission over fiber. The type of SFP module must match the fiber being used:

- Single-mode fiber (OS2) for long-distance connections
- Multimode fiber (OM3/OM4) for shorter distances, such as within a building Fiber connections typically require duplex cabling, meaning two strands: one for transmitting and one for receiving. The fiber patch cords should have LC-style connectors and must be connected in a reversed manner between switches (A to B, B to A) to ensure proper signal flow .

Cascading Switches

Fiber optic ports can also be used to cascade switches, connecting one switch to another to expand the network. This is often done in a star or tree topology, with a core switch connecting to multiple distribution switches . When cascading:

- Ensure the optical modules are compatible (single-mode vs. multimode, wavelength, and transmit/receive power)
- Match the port speed and duplex mode of the switches
- Limit cascades to a practical number of layers (commonly no more than four) to maintain performance

Practical Tips

- Use pre-terminated fiber patch cords for simplicity and reliability
- Verify that the switch port is set to fiber mode if it is a combo port (shared with RJ45 copper)
- For higher bandwidth, use SFP+ (10G) or QSFP modules as needed By following these guidelines, fiber optic cables can be safely and effectively connected to the back of a switch, enabling high-speed, long-distance network links.
