1. Visual and Physical Inspection

- Examine the physical condition of the distribution box (DB) and sub-distribution boxes (SDBs) for cracks, corrosion, or water ingress ().
 - Ensure cables are properly routed, not overlapping or damaged, and that welding or temporary power cables are elevated to prevent tripping hazards ().
 - Verify that covers, blanks, and enclosures are intact to prevent accidental contact with live parts ().
- #### 2. Check Protective Devices
- Inspect circuit breakers, fuses, and ELCBs for correct ratings and proper functioning ().
 - Test ELCBs/RCBs at 30 mA sensitivity to detect leakage currents that could indicate potential short circuits ().

- Ensure MCBs and RCCBs operate correctly and trip under fault conditions (). 3. Grounding and Earthing Verification

- Confirm that the earth conductor is properly connected to the DB/SDB and that grounding meets site safety standards ().

- Check for continuity of grounding and absence of corrosion or loose connections, which can contribute to short circuits (). 4. Electrical Testing

- Use a multimeter or insulation tester to measure resistance between live conductors and earth; low resistance may indicate a short circuit ().

- Inspect for hot spots or overheating in cables and connections, which can signal potential short circuits ().

- Test GFCI/GFCI-protected circuits to ensure they trip correctly under simulated fault conditions (). 5. Compliance and Documentation

- Ensure all inspections comply with OSHA or local electrical safety standards for construction sites ().

- Maintain a logbook of inspections, tests, and corrective actions, countersigned by a certified inspector ().

- Verify that warning labels, danger signage, and access control are in place to prevent unauthorized tampering (). 6. Preventive Measures

- Keep the area around DBs dry, clean, and free from combustible materials ().

- Implement routine checks before first use each day, especially for temporary power setups ().

- Assign ownership of electrical inspections to a qualified electrician or safety officer to ensure accountability (). By following these steps, construction sites can minimize the risk of short circuits, electric shock, and fire hazards, ensuring both worker safety and regulatory compliance.
