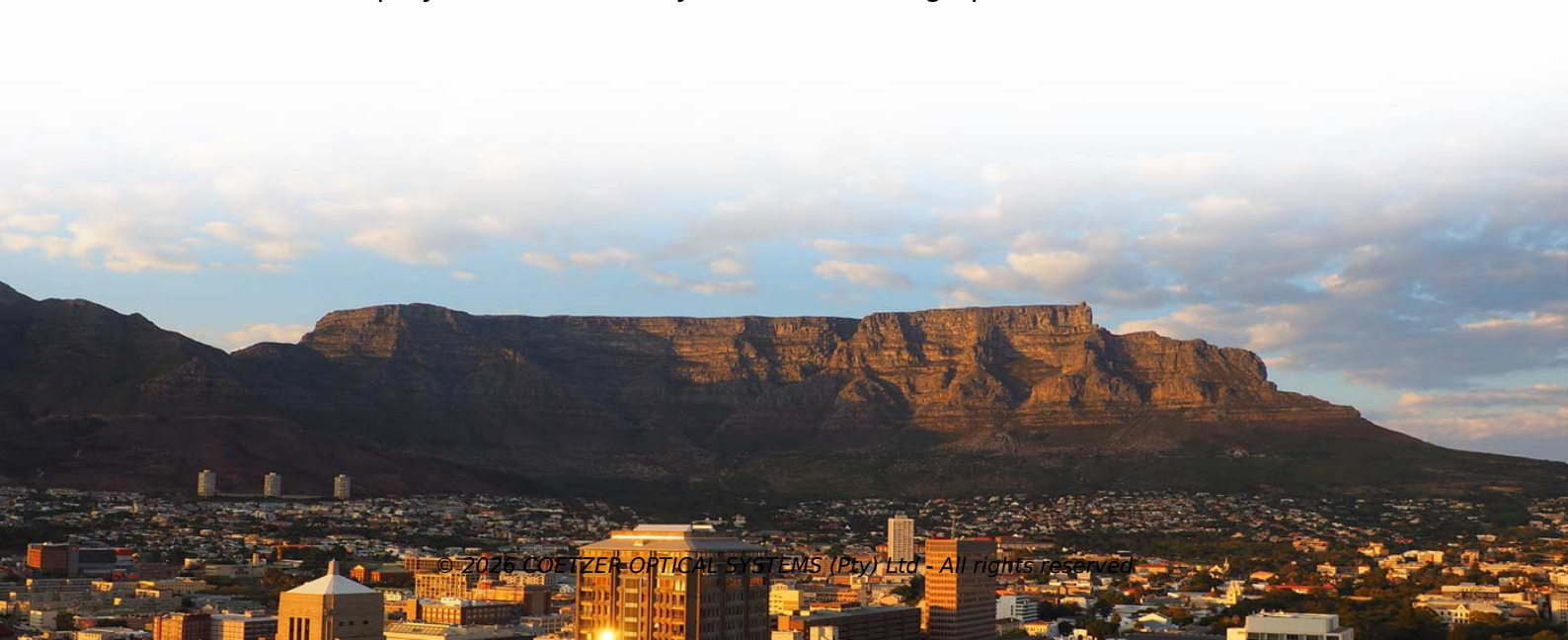


Color sequence for cable wiring in distribution box



Overview

Color sequences are the base and/or stripe colors that are assigned to each conductor in the cable. Tip: When using both old and new wires, use labels to identify them. The US uses the National Electrical Code (NEC) in wiring. Note: Large conductors tend to come in only black and are labeled with colored tape at each end. For typical building AC circuits (commonly up to 600 volts nominal), the NEC specifies identification rules for grounded conductors (neutral), requirements. Cable color codes assign specific colors to wires in electrical, data, and control systems to indicate their function—such as power, ground, or signal. Different regions follow standards like NEC (North America) or IEC (Europe) to ensure safety, prevent wiring errors, and simplify maintenance. By. To avoid mixing up the wires.
