Perforated Cable Tray

Solid-Bottom Cable Tray



Solid-bottom trays are fully enclosed without ventilation holes, providing complete protection for sensitive cables such as fiber optic or signal cables. They are commonly used in data centers, hospitals, and clean rooms, where protection from dust, moisture, and electromagnetic interference is critical .

Wire Mesh (Basket) Cable Tray

Wire mesh trays, also called basket trays, are made from welded steel wires, forming a flexible and lightweight structure. They are easy to modify on-site and ideal for low-voltage, data, and telecom cables. Wire mesh trays are widely used in IT networks, office buildings, and data centers due to their adaptability and quick installation .

Channel Cable Tray

Channel trays are U-shaped or C-shaped and provide support for smaller cable runs or branch connections. They are often used where visual aesthetics or minimal cable weight is required, and can be ventilated or solid-bottom depending on the application .
