Configuring an access switch involves setting up basic management, VLANs, access ports, IP addressing, and security to ensure proper network connectivity and control.

Initial Setup

- Check Hardware and Power On: Verify the switch model, inspect cables, and ensure indicator lights function correctly .

- Console Access: Connect via a console cable using software like PuTTY at 9600 baud to access the CLI .

- Erase Previous Configurations: For spare switches, delete any old VLAN configurations (e.g., flash:vlan.dat) to start fresh .

Basic Management Configuration

- Set Hostname and Domain Name: Assign a descriptive hostname and domain name for identification in the network .

- Configure Passwords: Set enable, console, and Telnet/SSH passwords to secure access .

- Enable Secure Management: Disable unencrypted protocols (HTTP, Telnet) and enable HTTPS and SSH for secure remote management .

VLAN and IP Configuration

- Create VLANs: Define VLANs for different network segments using vlan [vlan-number] commands .
- Assign Access Ports: Configure switch ports to belong to specific VLANs using interface and switchport access vlan [vlan-number] .
- Set Management IP: Assign an IP address to the management VLAN to allow remote access via CLI or web interface .
- Configure Default Gateway: Set the switch's default gateway to enable communication with other networks .

Security and Optimization

- Disable Unused Ports: Shut down unused ports to prevent unauthorized access .
- Enable Port Security: Limit MAC addresses per port to enhance security.
- Configure SNMP: Enable SNMP for monitoring and management by a Network Management System (NMS), .
- Save Configuration: Use write memory or copy running-config startup-config to save changes .

Access Methods

- CLI: Provides full control and is preferred for advanced configurations .
- GUI/Web Interface: Easier for basic management; access via the switch's IP address using a browser and login credentials . By following these steps, an access switch can be properly configured for secure, efficient, and manageable network operation.
