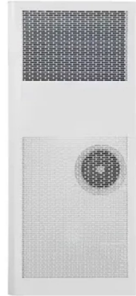


Cooling aisle inside the rack



Overview

In cold aisle containment, the cold aisle is enclosed. This traps the cold air directly in front of the racks, ensuring that servers always receive consistent inlet temperatures.
