Fiber optic terminal boxes (FTBs), also known as optical terminal boxes (OTBs), are passive devices used in FTTH networks to manage, terminate, and protect fiber optic cables . They serve as the interface between distribution fibers and drop fibers, providing strain relief, bend-radius control, and organized storage for fiber splices and adapters . Their primary function is optical management, not network communication. MAC addresses are unique identifiers assigned to network interface devices such as routers, switches, or optical network terminals (ONTs), which actively transmit and receive data over a network . Since FTBs do not process or forward data—they simply terminate and organize fibers—they do not contain any electronics or network interfaces that would require a MAC address. In contrast, devices like ONTs or routers connected to the FTB do have MAC addresses because they convert optical signals into electrical signals and participate in network communication . The FTB merely provides a physical connection point for these devices. Key Points:

- FTBs are passive optical devices for fiber termination and management .
- They do not transmit or receive network data, so they do not have MAC addresses.

- MAC addresses are only present in active network devices like ONTs, routers, or switches .
- FTBs ensure signal integrity and protection but are not part of the network layer. Thus, while FTBs are essential for fiber network infrastructure, they are not networked devices and do not possess MAC addresses.
