- Spare Ways: Include extra slots for future circuits.
- Enclosure Protection: Indoor boxes should have appropriate IP ratings, be made of durable materials, and comply with local electrical codes .
- Compliance: Ensure the box meets standards such as IEC 61439, UL/NEC, or regional codes like BS 7671 .

Safety Considerations

- Always ensure the area around the panel is dry and accessible .
- Use reliable circuit breakers and protective devices to prevent fire hazards .
- Consider dual RCD boards to reduce the impact of group tripping, ensuring some circuits remain operational if one trips .
- Installation and maintenance should ideally be performed by a licensed electrician to comply with local regulations .
