- Cable preparation: Stripping, cleaning, and organizing fibers for splicing.
- Splice tray and closure management: Proper placement of splices in trays and closures.
- Testing and troubleshooting: Using OTDRs (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometers) to measure splice loss and network performance .
