A fiber distribution box is primarily used for the wiring connection of optical cables and optical communication equipment. It facilitates the routing of optical signals through adapters and jumpers, enabling efficient optical wiring and distribution. It serves as a network-node splicing device, connecting multiple fiber cables while protecting them from environmental factors. Key Features:

- Large-capacity enclosure for splicing and branching.
 - Provides environmental protection against moisture, dust, and mechanical stress.
 - Supports rack-mounted or wall-mounted installation depending on network requirements.
 - Contains splice trays, couplings, and pigtails for organized fiber management .
- Applications:

- Outdoor high-capacity network nodes
- Mid-span fiber access points
- Underground or aerial fiber installations
