Its main function is to convert optical signals into electrical signals that your router can use, acting as a bridge between the fiber network and your local network . The ONT typically has an optical input port for the fiber cable and one or more Ethernet output ports for connecting networking devices .

Step-by-Step Connection Process

- **Prepare the Equipment:** Ensure you have the ONT, a fiber-ready router, and a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher recommended) for optimal speeds .
- **Install the Terminal Box:** Mount the fiber optic terminal box on a wall or cable rack, leaving at least 20 cm of space for cable management . Secure it using screws or other suitable fasteners.

- **Connect the Fiber Cable:** Carefully cut and clean the fiber cable end, then insert it into the ONT's optical port. Handle the fiber connector by its plastic housing to avoid damage, and ensure it clicks securely into place .
 - **Link the ONT to the Router:** Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN or Ethernet output port to the WAN/Internet port on your router. This allows the router to distribute the internet connection to your devices .
 - **Power Up the Devices:** Plug in the ONT first and wait for it to establish a connection with your service provider. Once the ONT is stable, power on the router. Check the ONT's indicator lights to confirm proper operation, typically a solid green light indicates power and connectivity .
 - **Test the Connection:** Use a fiber optic cable tester or check your router's internet status to ensure the connection is active and performing at expected speeds .
- Best Practices**
- Place both the ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near a power outlet, ideally with surge protection .
 - Avoid bending or stressing the fiber cable, as it is sensitive to damage.
 - Keep the fiber connectors clean and covered when not in use to prevent signal loss.
- By following these steps, your fiber optic terminal box will be properly connected to your router, enabling high-speed internet access throughout your network .
