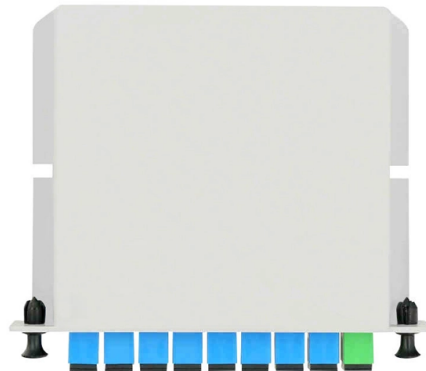


Function of cable trays and cable tray connecting wires

Cables should be grouped by function or voltage to prevent interference and simplify maintenance .

Securing Cables



Once placed, cables are fastened using cable ties, straps, or hold-down clamps. These secure the wires to the tray without compressing or damaging insulation. Proper spacing between ties is important to prevent sagging and allow for thermal expansion or future adjustments . For larger or heavier cables, additional support may be required at intervals along the tray.

Grounding and Bonding

Metallic cable trays must be grounded and bonded to maintain electrical safety. Bonding jumpers are used across tray sections to ensure continuity, and the tray itself can serve as an equipment grounding conductor if approved by the manufacturer . This reduces the risk of electrical faults and ensures compliance with electrical codes.

Exiting and Connecting to Equipment

Cables exit the tray at designated points using drop-outs or fittings to connect to equipment below or to branch off to other trays. Care is taken to avoid sharp bends and maintain bend radius limits to prevent damage to the conductors . Labels are often applied to cables for identification and troubleshooting.
