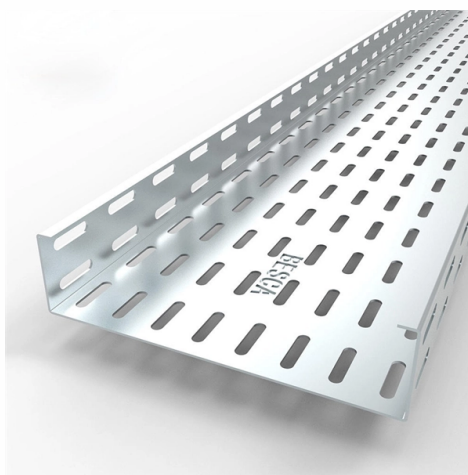


Grounding and PE wire of the distribution box casing

Key Principles of Grounding a Distribution Box

Protective Earthing (PE) involves connecting all exposed conductive parts of the distribution box, including the casing, to the ground. This ensures that in the event of a fault, such as a live wire contacting the metal enclosure, the fault current safely flows to earth, triggering protective devices like circuit breakers or RCDs to disconnect power and prevent electric shock (Web result).

Connection Points and Wire Selection

- **Locate the PE Bar or Grounding Terminal:** Open the distribution box and identify the grounding bar or terminal marked with "PE" or a grounding symbol. This is the main connection point for the grounding wire (Web result).
- **Wire Type and Size:** Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire. The cross-sectional area should meet local standards—commonly 6 mm² outside the US or 10 AWG in the US. This wire provides good conductivity and a clear visual warning (Web result).

- **Connection Method:** Strip the wire to the required length, attach it securely to the PE bar or pre-welded stud on the metal casing, and tighten the screw firmly. For stainless steel enclosures, remove oxide layers or coatings at the contact point to reduce resistance, and consider using conductive paste to prevent corrosion (Web result).
- **Bonding Moving Parts:** For hinged doors or panels, use flexible copper braided tape to maintain a reliable connection despite movement. Anti-loosening washers are recommended to prevent loosening over time (Web result).

Grounding Resistance and Safety

- The total grounding resistance should comply with low-voltage distribution standards, typically below 0.1 Ohm for industrial systems (Web result).
 - If multiple components or spindles are connected, ensure parallel grounding paths are calculated to maintain low resistance and effective fault clearing (Web result).
- #### Additional Precautions
- Clearly mark all grounding connections for inspection and maintenance.
 - Ensure all electrical components inside the box that require grounding are connected to the PE bar.
 - Verify that the grounding system complies with local codes such as NFPA 70 (NEC) or the Canadian Electrical Code (Web result). By following these guidelines, the distribution box casing will be safely grounded, reducing the risk of electric shock, equipment damage, and ensuring compliance with electrical safety standards.
