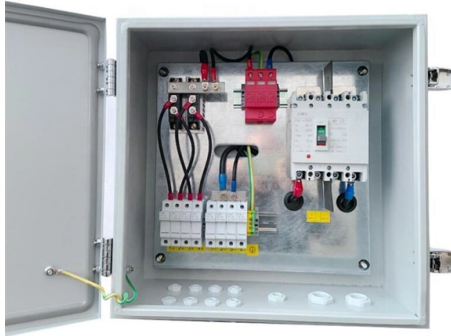


How long should it take to strip the fiber optic splice box
