- Future expansion: Many double-layer boards include spare ways for future circuits, so the total installed circuits may be fewer than the maximum ways available . In summary, a double-layer distribution box doubles the circuit capacity of a single-layer board, typically supporting 24 to 36 circuits, depending on the number of ways and protective devices used.
