These racks are typically 19-inch, 2–2.6 meters in height, and support multiple fiber connector types like SC, LC, FC, and E2000, allowing for flexible network design and high port density.

Modular and Scalable Design

Many ODF racks are modular, supporting a range of 12–144 cores per patch panel, which allows network operators to start with a smaller configuration and expand as needed . Features such as integrated splice trays, patch panels, and cable management systems help organize fibers, protect them from damage, and simplify maintenance . High-density 144-core 4U ODF racks, for example, combine splicing and patching in a compact design, making them ideal for FTTH networks or decentralized distribution hubs .
