In the majority of single-family residences, one main service panel serves as the primary distribution box. This panel receives power from the utility meter and distributes it to all branch circuits in the home, protecting them with circuit breakers or fuses . Additional distribution boxes, called subpanels, may be installed when the main panel reaches capacity or when a distant area, such as a garage or basement, requires its own distribution point . Subpanels are powered from the main panel and do not count as separate primary distribution boxes.

Commercial and Industrial Installations



For larger buildings or facilities, multiple primary distribution boxes may be installed to handle higher loads and provide redundancy. Primary distribution systems can include radial feeders, primary loops, or radially operated networks, depending on the required reliability . For example, a spot network serving a high-rise building or shopping mall may be fed by two to six primary feeders to ensure continuous power supply . These primary feeders connect to network transformers, which then supply secondary distribution systems.

Factors Affecting the Number of Primary Boxes

- Load size and type: Higher electrical demand or specialized equipment may require multiple primary panels.
- Reliability requirements: Critical facilities often use multiple feeders or primary selective service to maintain power during faults .
- Building layout: Large or multi-story buildings may need more than one primary distribution box to minimize voltage drop and simplify wiring.
- Regulatory and safety codes: Local electrical codes may dictate the number and configuration of primary distribution boxes.
