- Preventive maintenance: Early detection of faults or calibration drift reduces the risk of costly failures and enhances system longevity.

Testing and Renewal Process

- Bench Testing: Verifies the relay functions according to its design specifications independently of the system.
- Commissioning Testing: Confirms that the relay operates correctly within the larger electrical system, including interactions with switchgear and interlocks.
- Documentation: Records of testing and calibration must be maintained to demonstrate compliance and support future audits . In summary, a relay protection certificate is valid for two years, after which the relay must undergo testing and calibration to renew the certification, ensuring continued reliability and safety of the electrical system.
