

How to connect a router after replacing the fiber optic box in a fiber optic home

To reconnect your router after replacing the fiber optic box, connect the fiber cable to the ONT, link the ONT to your router via Ethernet, power on both devices, and configure your router settings.

Step-by-Step Connection

1. Prepare Your Equipment Ensure you have the following:

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP, which converts the fiber signal into an electrical signal your router can use.
- Fiber optic cable from your ISP, usually with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors.
- Ethernet cable (Cat5e, Cat6, or higher) to connect the ONT to your router.

2. Connect the Fiber Cable to the ONT

- Router capable of handling high-speed fiber connections, ideally fiber-ready or supporting gigabit speeds .
- Locate the fiber wall outlet or termination point where the ISP's fiber enters your home.
- Remove protective caps from both the fiber cable and the ONT port.

- Carefully insert the fiber cable into the ONT's designated port until it clicks securely. Handle the fiber connector by its plastic housing to avoid damage . 3. Link the ONT to Your Router

- Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN or Ethernet output port to the WAN/Internet port on your router.

- Ensure the Ethernet cable is fully seated in both ports to prevent connectivity issues . 4. Power On Devices

- Plug in the ONT first and wait for its status lights to stabilize, which may take 2-5 minutes. A solid green power light indicates proper operation.

- After the ONT is ready, power on your router and wait for its indicator lights to confirm a successful connection . 5. Configure Your Router

- Access the router's admin panel via a web browser using its IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1).

- Follow the setup wizard to configure your internet connection and Wi-Fi network.

- Change the default username and password to secure your network . 6. Verify Connectivity

- Run a speed test or connect a device to check internet access.

- If issues persist, ensure all cables are properly connected and the ONT has fully booted .

Additional Tips

- Place the ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near power outlets.

- Use a surge protector to safeguard your devices.

- Avoid bending or stressing the fiber cable, as it is sensitive to damage . Following these steps will restore your home network after replacing the fiber optic box, ensuring stable and high-speed internet connectivity.

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
