

How to connect a two-way power cable to a distribution box

To connect a two-way power cable to a distribution box, connect the phase (live) and neutral wires to the input terminals of the main MCB, and the earth wire to the earth link, then distribute the output to the branch MCBs or RCCBs as required.

Step-by-Step Connection

1. Identify the Cable Wires A two-way power cable typically has three conductors: phase (live), neutral, and earth. Ensure each wire is clearly marked or color-coded (commonly brown/red for live, blue/black for neutral, and green/yellow for earth) before connecting. 2. Turn Off Power Supply Before starting, ensure the main power supply is switched off to prevent electric shock. 3. Connect to the Main MCB

- Connect the phase (live) wire from the incoming cable to the input terminal of the main MCB.
 - Connect the neutral wire to the neutral input terminal of the main MCB or directly to the neutral link if using an RCCB after the MCB.
 - Connect the earth wire to the earth terminal or earth bus bar in the distribution box
- . 4. Connect to Protective Devices

- If using an RCCB, connect the output of the main MCB to the input of the RCCB.
- For branch circuits, connect the phase wire from the RCCB output to the input of single-pole or double-pole MCBs depending on the load.
- Connect the neutral wire from the RCCB output to the neutral link for distribution to branch circuits.
- Connect the earth wire to the earth link for all branch circuits . 5. Organize and Secure Wires
- Use plastic ties to bind wires neatly, keeping them straight and avoiding tangles.
- Maintain proper spacing and ensure wires are not under tension . 6. Labeling and Safety Checks
- Clearly mark the AC voltage, phase, and neutral connections.
- Perform a safety inspection to check for short circuits, loose connections, or overload risks before switching on the power . 7. Power On and Test
- Once all connections are secure and verified, switch on the main supply.
- Test each branch circuit to ensure proper operation and that protective devices function correctly. By following these steps, the two-way power cable will be safely integrated into the distribution box, ensuring proper distribution of electricity to all connected loads while maintaining safety standards .
