Use bend radius control clips to prevent sharp bends that could degrade signal quality. Secure the fiber trunk with cable ties or movable clips, but avoid over-tightening.

Step 5: Manage Excess Fiber

Store any extra fiber in the provided cassettes or loops inside the box to prevent stress or damage . Organize patch cords and branch fibers neatly using Velcro straps or cable organizers to maintain a clean and efficient setup .

Step 6: Test the Connection

After connecting the fibers, verify signal integrity using tools such as visual fault locators or Optical Time Domain Reflectometers (OTDRs) . Check for proper alignment, cleanliness, and absence of damage. Label each port and fiber for future reference and documentation.

Step 7: Final Checks

Ensure all connectors are locked in place, the fibers are properly routed, and the box is closed securely. Regular maintenance, including visual inspections and cleaning, will help maintain long-term performance .
