

How to connect the fiber optic interface junction box

- Maintain the standard bend radius and avoid sharp bends.

- Close the box securely to protect fibers from dust, moisture, and accidental handling .

Step 6: Test the Connection

- Use a fiber optic test device to verify signal integrity and continuity.
- Confirm that all connections are tight and functional.
- Contact your Internet or network provider to ensure the line is active and performing correctly .
