

How to connect the intelligent meter in the distribution box

1. Safety First Always turn off the main power supply before starting any electrical work. Use a voltage tester to ensure no live voltage is present at the meter terminals to prevent electric shock (). 2. Prepare the Distribution Box

- Select a suitable location inside the distribution box that complies with local electrical codes.
- Ensure the DIN rail is securely mounted if the meter is DIN rail-compatible (). 3. Mount the Meter
- Attach the intelligent meter to the DIN rail or mounting hardware provided.
- Ensure it is firmly secured to prevent movement or disconnection (). 4. Identify and Connect Wires

- Line (incoming) wires: Connect the phase (L1, L2, L3) and neutral wires from the utility supply to the meter terminals.

- ### 5. Verify Connections
- Double-check that all connections are tight and correctly positioned.
 - Ensure that the meter's On/Off state is safe before applying power, as some intelligent meters do not visually indicate load status before energization ().
- ### 6. Power-Up and Test
- Turn on the main power supply.
 - Observe the meter's LED indicators or use the associated app to confirm proper operation. For example, a solid green LED usually indicates normal functioning ().
 - If the meter supports Wi-Fi or Bluetooth, follow the app instructions to pair and monitor the device ().
- ### 7. Final Checks
- Ensure all circuit breakers in the distribution box are correctly rated and functional.
 - Verify that the meter is accurately recording energy consumption and that communication with monitoring systems (if applicable) is active ().
- ### Tools and Materials Needed
- Screwdrivers and wire strippers/cutters
 - Insulation tape
 - Voltage tester
 - Circuit breakers and cables as per load requirements
 - Mounting hardware for the meter ()
- ### Important Notes
- Never remove seals on utility meters without authorization ().
 - Only connect meters to circuits and systems that meet the manufacturer's technical requirements.
 - Consult a licensed electrician if unsure at any step to ensure safety and compliance with local regulations (). By following these steps, you can safely and efficiently connect an intelligent meter in a distribution box, ensuring accurate energy measurement and reliable operation.
