FW68 Fire Wire Linear Heat Sensing Cable Installation Instrustions ...

The terminal box has + and - indications marked on the PCB. It is recommended that the RED fire wire conductor is connected to the + terminal and the BLACK conductor be connected to the - terminal.

Field Installation of Thermocouple & RTD Temperature ...

Once the terminal head is in place, attach the conduit or flex cable to the conduit port. Pull the thermocouple extension wire through the conduit/flex tube into the terminal head or junction box.

Installing Linear heat detection cable (LHD) Applications

For proximity or special application protection, LHD cable should be installed on or immediately above the hazard in a way that allows for it to be exposed to a rise in temperature caused by a fire condition.
