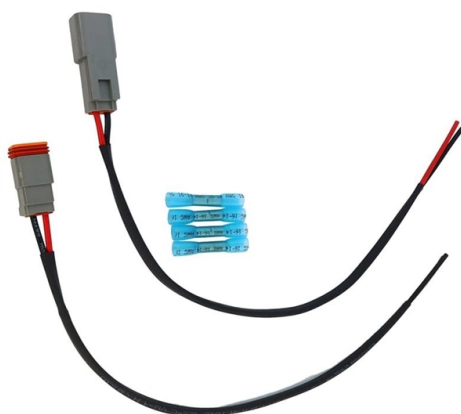

- Maintain bend radius limits to prevent fiber damage.
- Keep fibers clean and free of dust; even small contaminants can degrade performance.
- Leave extra slack in the panel for future re-termination or network expansion.
