Step 1: Gather Necessary Equipment

Before starting, ensure you have:

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP
- Fiber-compatible router with a WAN or SFP port
- Fiber optic cable (SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors)
- Ethernet cable (Cat6 or higher recommended)

- Power adapters for both ONT and router

Step 2: Connect the Fiber Line

- Locate the fiber wall outlet where the ISP's line enters your home.
- Plug the fiber optic cable into the wall outlet and the ONT's designated port.

- Power on the ONT and wait 2–5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize .

Step 3: Connect the ONT to Your Router

- Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port.
- Power on the router and check that the Power, Internet, and Wi-Fi LEDs turn green .

Step 4: Access Router Settings

- Connect a computer or mobile device to the router via LAN or Wi-Fi.
- Open a web browser and enter the router's default IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 10.0.0.2).

- Log in using the default credentials (usually admin/admin) and change the username and password for security .

Step 5: Configure Internet Connection

- Auto-detect (DHCP): Most home ISPs use DHCP, which the router can detect automatically.
- PPPoE: Enter the ISP-provided username and password.
- Static IP: Input the IP address, subnet mask, and gateway provided by your ISP .

Step 6: Set Up Wi-Fi

- Choose a network name (SSID) and a strong password.
- Select the appropriate band: 2.4 GHz for range, 5 GHz for speed.
- Enable Wi-Fi security (WPA3 or WPA2 recommended) to protect your network .

Step 7: Optimize Your Network

- Quality of Service (QoS): Prioritize devices or activities like video calls or gaming.
- Guest network: Keep your main Wi-Fi secure while allowing visitors access.
- Parental controls: Limit screen time and block inappropriate content if needed.
- Firmware updates: Ensure both router and ONT firmware are up to date for performance and security .

Step 8: Test and Troubleshoot

- Run a speed test to confirm proper connectivity.
- If the internet light is red or speeds are slow, check all cable connections, restart the router, or contact your ISP . Following these steps typically takes 15–30 minutes once the fiber line and ONT are installed, providing a fast, reliable, and secure fiber optic internet connection.
