

How to reset a router for cable fiber optic internet

Resetting your router can resolve connectivity issues by rebooting the device or restoring factory settings, but it should be done carefully to avoid losing custom configurations. Soft Reboot (Power Cycle)

A soft reboot is often the first step to fix slow or unstable internet without erasing settings:

- Turn off the router using the power switch or unplug it from the power source.
 - Wait at least 30 seconds to allow the device to fully power down and clear memory.
 - Turn the router back on and wait 1-2 minutes for it to reconnect to the internet .
- This method can resolve temporary glitches, refresh the IP address, and improve network performance.

Factory Reset

A factory reset restores the router to its default settings, erasing all custom configurations such as Wi-Fi passwords, port forwarding, and ISP credentials. Use this only if other troubleshooting steps fail.

Steps to Perform a Factory Reset:

- Locate the reset button on the back or underside of the router. It is usually a small recessed button labeled "Reset" .
- Prepare necessary tools such as a paperclip or pin to press the button.
- Power off the router (optional, depending on manufacturer instructions).
- Press and hold the reset button for 10-30 seconds until the router's LEDs blink or turn off and on .
- Release the button and wait for the router to fully reboot. This may take a few minutes.
- Reconfigure your network: Log in to the router's admin panel (commonly at 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) using the default username and password, and re-enter your ISP settings if required .

Additional Tips:

- Backup settings before resetting if possible, using the router's web interface or mobile app .
- Notify household members that the internet will be temporarily unavailable.
- Check cable connections to ensure the WAN/ONT, LAN, and power cables are secure .
- Place the router in a ventilated area to prevent overheating and maintain performance . By following these steps, you can effectively reset your cable or fiber optic router, resolve connectivity issues, and restore optimal network performance.
