Identify the welding machine's voltage and amperage requirements. Most MIG, TIG, or Stick welders operate at 240V and require 50A or higher depending on the machine size and duty cycle . Check the welder's data plate or manual to confirm the maximum input current.

Step 2: Select the Circuit Breaker and Wire

Install a double-pole breaker in the distribution box rated for the welder's maximum amperage. For a 50A circuit, use 6 AWG copper wire with two insulated hot conductors and a bare or green grounding conductor . Ensure the breaker protects the wiring and the welder from overcurrent.

Step 3: Install the Welding Outlet

Use a NEMA 6-50R receptacle for a 50A, 240V welding circuit. Connect the two hot wires to the brass terminals and the grounding wire to the green screw terminal. Route the wiring through protective conduit to prevent mechanical damage .

Step 4: Grounding

Proper grounding is critical for safety. Connect the welding machine's metal enclosure to the grounding conductor in the distribution box. Additionally, ground the workpiece or welding table to a suitable earth ground, such as a metal building frame, independent of the welding machine ground . This ensures the enclosure and workpiece are at the same potential, reducing the risk of electric shock.

Step 5: Distribution Box Wiring

For the incoming line to the distribution box, use a five-wire system: three-phase lines (if applicable), neutral, and ground. For single-phase 240V welding circuits, connect one phase to each hot terminal of the breaker, the neutral if required by the machine, and the ground to the panel's grounding bus . Ensure all connections are tight and properly insulated.

Step 6: Safety Checks

- Turn off the main breaker before wiring.
- Use a voltage tester to confirm no power is present.
- Wear insulated gloves and safety glasses.
- Verify all connections are secure before energizing the circuit . Following these steps ensures a safe, reliable, and code-compliant electrical setup for shielded welding operations, providing stable power and minimizing the risk of electrical hazards.
