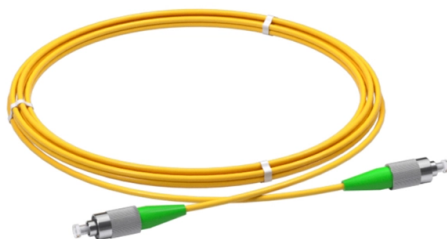

Before powering on a Huawei switch, verify the external power supply using a multimeter to ensure there is no short-circuit between the phase (live), neutral, and ground wires, and confirm the input voltage is within the switch's operating range . Always turn off the external power supply and the switch or power module before connecting cables. Wear an ESD wrist strap or gloves to prevent electrostatic discharge damage . After connecting, turn on the external power supply first, then the switch or power module. When powering off, save the configuration to avoid restoring the last saved state .

Switch Setting Function

Huawei switches include an Intelligent Switch Setting feature that can be enabled or disabled. To disable it, navigate to Maintenance > Intelligent Operations > Switch Setting and set it to Disable . This function helps manage power and operational parameters automatically, but disabling it allows manual control over switch behavior.

Power Module Considerations

Some switches have pluggable or independent power modules. For these, it is recommended to turn off the switch before powering off the modules to protect the hardware . Devices without external power modules can be powered off directly. Frequent power cycling should be avoided unless necessary, as enterprise switches are designed for continuous operation.

Safety and Reliability

- Check connections: Ensure all power cables are correctly connected and secure .
- Backup configuration: Always save the current configuration before powering off to prevent data loss .
- Voltage compliance: Confirm the external power supply matches the switch's voltage requirements .
- ESD protection: Use wrist straps or gloves to prevent static damage .
