Material and Design



Copper is preferred for these contact pieces due to its excellent electrical conductivity, durability, and resistance to corrosion. The copper terminal block is typically a straight metal strip that can be mechanically fixed to the distribution cabinet rack, allowing for a compact and systematic layout with other components like circuit breakers and disconnect switches . Proper sizing and positioning of the copper block are essential to maintain neat wiring and comply with industrial power distribution standards.

Installation Considerations

- **Alignment with Incoming Line:** The copper contact piece should be positioned to match the incoming cable entry, providing a clear access channel for the main power line .
- **Mechanical Fixing:** It is securely mounted to the cabinet frame to prevent movement and ensure stable electrical contact .
- **Integration with Protective Devices:** The copper block connects directly to the main switch or isolator and feeds the busbars, which then supply individual circuits .
- **Safety Measures:** Insulating sleeves or shrouds are often used to prevent accidental contact with live parts, and proper grounding is maintained through earth bars .

Applications

- **Residential Distribution Boxes:** Typically handle single-phase power with copper terminals connecting the main supply to multiple MCBs for lighting, outlets, and appliances .
- **Commercial and Industrial Boxes:** Designed for three-phase power, higher currents, and integration with MCCBs, RCDs, or disconnect switches, where copper contact pieces provide a robust and organized connection platform .
