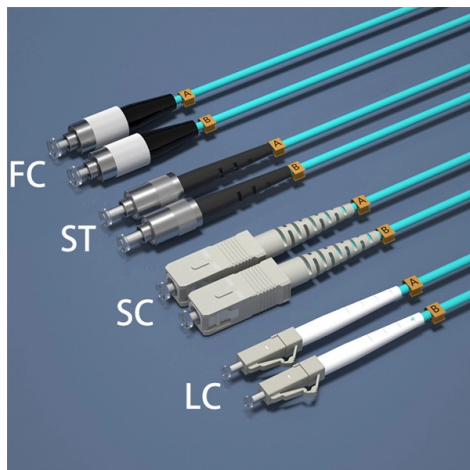


Installation of Perforated Cable Trays

The perforations allow for flexible cable routing and branch connections without specialized fittings. Maintain continuous structural support and verify that all connections are tight to prevent sagging or misalignment .

Cable Laying

Lay cables neatly within the tray, separating by voltage or function as required. Use cable ties or straps to secure cables, leaving sufficient slack for thermal expansion or future adjustments. The perforated design provides ventilation to prevent overheating and allows easy access for maintenance or modifications .

Compliance and Safety

Follow National Electrical Code (NEC) or local electrical standards, including grounding, clearances, and cable type requirements. Conduct inspections and testing according to the approved Inspection & Test Plan. Ensure all personnel are trained and competent, and that unsafe conditions are corrected before proceeding .

Verify that all trays, fittings, and grounding connections conform to approved designs and specifications .
