- Ensure all wire joints are tight, insulated, and free from exposed live parts.
- Organize cables neatly to prevent tangling and allow easy identification of circuits .

- Properly ground the distribution box and all metallic components to prevent electrical hazards.
- Install protection devices such as fuses, breakers, and surge protectors for each circuit.
- Use industrial plug sockets (CEE connectors) for heavy machinery to ensure secure and stable connections, especially in outdoor or high-traffic areas .

Step 6: Testing and Commissioning

Before powering the system:

- Perform visual inspections to check for loose connections or exposed wires.
- Use a multimeter to verify correct voltage, continuity, and grounding.
- Label all circuits clearly for easy identification and future maintenance .

- Schedule regular inspections to ensure long-term reliability.
- Keep the area around the box clear for ventilation and maintenance.
