Per-Foot Wiring Costs: For low-voltage installations, electricians generally charge \$0.40 to \$0.62 per linear foot for wiring inside cabinets or structured cabling runs, which is lower than standard high-voltage wiring costs (\$6–\$8 per linear foot) due to lower power requirements and simpler insulation needs . For structured wiring handling communication or entertainment devices, an additional \$2 per foot may apply . **Labor Rates:** Electricians' hourly rates vary by experience and region.
