

## Method for removing optical modules



### Overview

Ensure that you clean the optic surfaces of the fiber cables before you plug them back into the optical ports of another SFP module.

To remove an optical module safely, you typically need no special tools beyond an ESD wrist strap, though a small flat-head screwdriver may be required for certain latch designs.

#### Safety Precautions

Before removing an optical module, always:

- Wear an ESD wrist strap or ESD gloves to prevent electrostatic discharge that can damage the module .
- Power off the device or disable the port in the device settings to avoid electrical damage .
- Work in a clean, dust-free environment and avoid touching the optical contacts or bores .

- Keep dust caps on the module and fiber connectors until ready to reconnect .

#### Step-by-Step Removal

- Disconnect Optical Fibers: Release any locking clips on the fiber connectors (LC, MPO, SC, etc.) and gently pull the fibers out. Cover the connectors with dust caps immediately .

- **Release the Module Latch:** Identify the latch mechanism on the module. This could be a clasp, tab, or release ring. Push, slide, or rotate the latch according to the module design .
- **Remove the Module:** Grasp the module by its edges or pull tab, not the optical connector, and pull it straight out from the slot. Avoid twisting or applying excessive force .
- **Store Safely:** Place the removed module in an anti-static bag to protect it from ESD and contamination .
- **Install Dust Cover:** Insert a dust cover into the empty slot to protect the port from dust and debris .

#### Optional Tools

- **Small flat-head screwdriver:** Only needed if the module has a retaining clip that cannot be released by hand .
- **Lint-free wipes and fiber cleaning tools:** Useful if you plan to clean the optical interfaces before reinsertion .

Following these steps ensures the optical module and device ports remain undamaged, maintaining network reliability and performance.
