

Municipal fiber optic communication costs



Overview

According to the MTA, the cost of connecting each traffic signal to fiber is approximately \$150,000 if implemented independently. If the proposed network is deployed, MTA could avoid potentially up to \$141 million in construction costs (\$150,000 per signal x 940 remaining. Mesh networks provide reliable user connections and are also faster to build and less expensive to run than the hub and spoke configurations. Internet connections can also be secured through the addition of a wireless router to an existing wired connection – a convenient method for Internet access.
