- **Environmental Protection:** Outdoor FDBs are often IP65 rated, dustproof, waterproof, and UV-resistant, while indoor boxes may have lower IP ratings but can include fire-rated materials .
- **Mounting Options:** FDBs can be wall-mounted, pole-mounted, or installed inside cabinets, depending on network requirements .
- **Internal Structure:** Many FDBs include splice trays, splitter trays, and adapter brackets, allowing direct connections and organized fiber management .
- **Material and Durability:** High-impact ABS+PC materials ensure long-term mechanical protection for delicate fiber splices .

When choosing an FDB for ODF integration:

- **Capacity Requirements:** Match the fiber count with current needs and allow a 30-50% buffer for future growth .
- **Environmental Conditions:** Ensure the box meets IP rating and temperature tolerance for the installation site .
- **Accessibility:** Consider how often the box will be accessed for maintenance or new connections .
- **Compatibility:** Ensure the FDB can interface with existing ODFs, splitters, and patch panels for seamless network operation .
