Overview

Wiring Direction: Wiring between the main circuit breaker and each branch circuit breaker in the box generally goes on the left, and the wiring out of the distribution box generally goes on the right. Binding Requirements: The wires should be bound with. A distribution board or distribution box is where the main power supply is distributed to multiple loads. It includes isolator, RCCB (Residual current circuit breaker) or RCD (Residual-current device) devices, protective fuses or MCB's (Miniature Circuit Breaker). Distribution Board also known as "Panel Board", "Switch & Fuse Board" or "Consumer Unit" is a box installed in the building containing on protective devices, such as circuit breaker, fuses, isolator, switches, RCDs and MCBs etc. Power supply is received from LT panel and distributed to the outgoing feeders for utilization.
