- Sealed connector housings to prevent moisture and corrosion.
- Pre-installed terminals with plated contacts (often tin or gold) for consistent low-resistance electrical connections.
- Strain relief to reduce fatigue in high-vibration areas.
- Enables plug-and-play repairs, circuit extensions, or retrofitting accessories while maintaining OEM-quality performance .
