

Re-inspection of cable distribution boxes upon arrival at the site



Overview

You perform a visual inspection and then measure the continuity of the protective conductor up to the protective contacts of the sockets. Furthermore, you check whether the residual current device is type A, with a tripping current of a maximum of 30 mA. The inspection site is specified to clarify the area being assessed. An engineer or staff member responsible for site electrical safety & compliance reviews the inspection. CABLES – Whether the condition of Cable is checked?
