- Multimode (OM3, OM4, OM5): Suitable for short-distance, high-speed data center applications. OM4 and OM5 offer higher bandwidth and longer reach than OM3, making them future-proof for 10G, 25G, or 100G Ethernet deployments .

Connector Types

- LC connectors: Compact, high-density, preferred in modern switches and data centers.

- SC connectors: Larger, easier to handle, commonly used in FTTH or CATV installations.

- MPO/MTP: Recommended for high-density parallel transmission, such as 100G or 400G modules .

Jacket and Application Considerations

- Indoor cables: PVC or LSZH jackets for offices and riser spaces.
- Outdoor or weather-protected: Armored or FRNC-LSZH cables for durability and safety .
- Specialty options: Bend-insensitive fibers (G.657A1/A2) for tight spaces or FTTH applications .
