- **Test Connection:** Run a speed test or connect a device directly to the ONT to verify the fiber connection is functioning correctly .

- **Connector Cleaning:** Always clean fiber connectors before insertion to prevent signal degradation .
- **Cable Handling:** Avoid bending the fiber cable beyond its minimum bend radius and protect it from kinks or physical damage .
