An ST fiber optic patch cord is a short fiber cable with ST connectors at both ends, used to connect devices for high-speed optical signal transmission.

An ST (Straight Tip) fiber optic patch cord is a type of fiber optic cable terminated with ST connectors, which are cylindrical with a twist-lock bayonet coupling mechanism for secure connections. These connectors are standardized under IEC 61754-2 and feature a 2.5mm ceramic ferrule that ensures low insertion loss and stable signal transmission. ST patch cords are commonly used in datacom, telecom, and networking applications, connecting devices such as patch panels, switches, and optical equipment.

Fiber Types

ST patch cords are available in both single-mode (SM) and multimode (MM) variants:

- Single-mode (9/125 μm , OS1/OS2): Suitable for long-distance applications up to 10 km at 1310 nm wavelength, offering low attenuation.



- Multimode (50/125 µm OM3/OM4 or 62.5/125 µm OM1/OM2): Designed for short-distance, high-speed connections, supporting 10 Gigabit Ethernet up to 300–400 meters depending on the fiber type .

Construction and Features

- Tight-buffered fibers housed within a durable outer jacket for protection .
- Kevlar (aramid) yarn may be included as a strength member to enhance durability and resistance to pulls, snags, and impacts .
- Simplex or duplex configurations are available depending on whether one or two fibers are needed .
- Low insertion loss (typically ≤ 0.02 dB) ensures minimal signal degradation .
- Designed for indoor use, though some variants can be ruggedized for specific environments .

- Connecting patch panels to switches or routers in data centers.
- Linking telecom equipment for high-speed optical communication.
- Short-distance connections in LANs, FTTH, and enterprise networks .
