Materials such as fire-rated boards, firestop packs, firestop mastic, or mineral wool should be used. Gaps between firestop packs and cables should not exceed 1 cm², and packing thickness should meet design requirements.  - Ensure the penetration is precisely sized to minimize gaps.
 - Use corrosion-resistant frames or inserts for long-term durability.
